About Firas certification

Having the confidence of ensuring that your building is safe is knowing that the fire protection products and systems have been correctly installed so that they will perform correctly in the event of a fire.

The correct installation of fire protection products and systems is vital in the effective management of fire safety.

Why choose a Firas certificated installation contractor?

FIRAS is a UKAS accredited third party certification scheme designed for the certification of competent installers involved in the fire protection industry and comprises 3 industry related schemes for:

- Installers of Passive Fire Protection Products and Systems
- Installers of Commercial and Industrial Sprinkler Systems
- Installers of Residential and Domestic Sprinkler Systems

The Scheme assesses the technical capability of the installation contractor, the competence of the contractor's personnel and regularly inspects on-going contracts for compliance with the scheme and the relevant specifications. It aims to protect the fire protection industry (and it's clients), from the consequences of having work installed by "Rogue Contractors" who carry out poor installations and work outside of standards and tested constructions.

Apply to join Firas

The FIRAS Scheme is operated by Warrington Certification Limited, but is developed in conjunction with industry through representative trade associations in each sector.

FIRAS operates as a Partnership with Industry. The scheme addresses the needs of the installation contractor and those of the specifier, main contractor, enforcement authority and building owner or occupier.

Technical Directory

Liaison between FIRAS and relevant industry groups is maintained through Sector Liaison Panels. The purpose of these panels is to develop and update the schemes, coordinate the views of industry and to promote the schemes.
